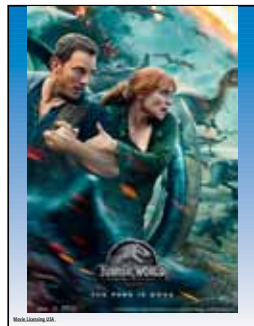
**September 13

SOLO: A STAR WARS STORY

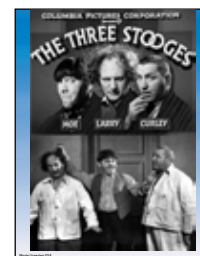
