Star Wars fans: Join your fellow Jedi's for an afternoon of out-of-this world activities and crafts. For ages 3-up.

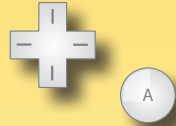

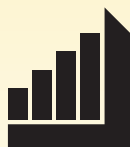
Princess Party! Saturday, April 30, 2 pm
