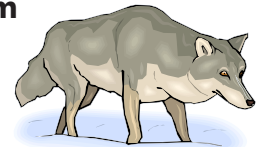
Tuesdays, September 11, October 9, November 13, December 11, 10:30-11:30 am

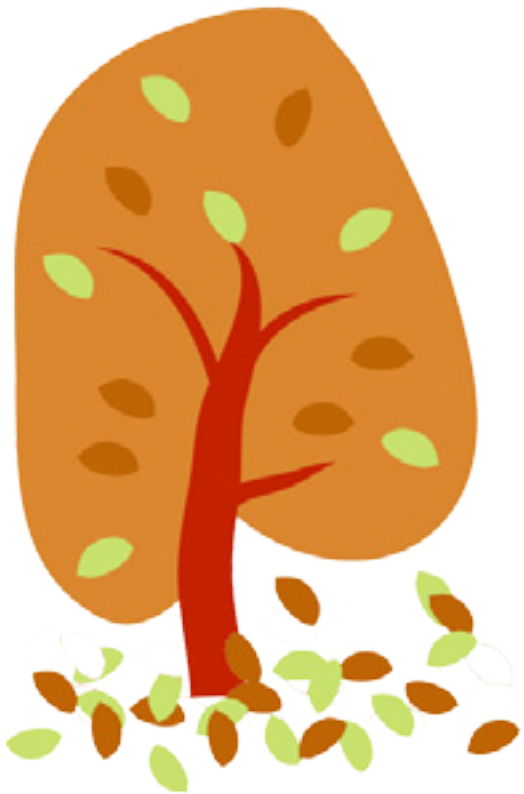
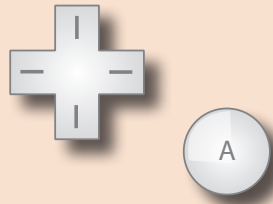

Join us as we explore a variety of fun artistic techniques! For grades K-6.

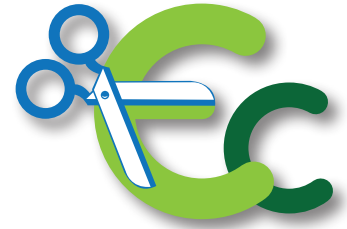
WII SPORTS
