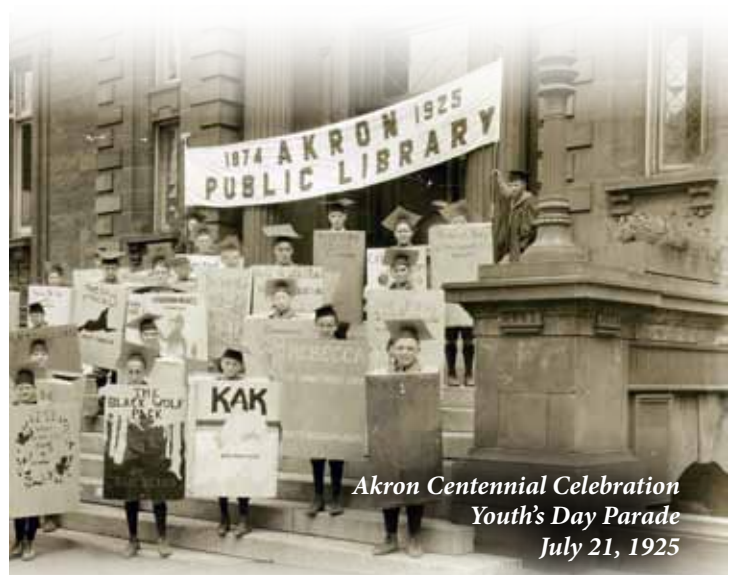
RECE Lab Back to School Open House
