Capture aliens, blast off into space, and make something out of this world! Help us celebrate our 20th Anniversary with fun and music all day long!

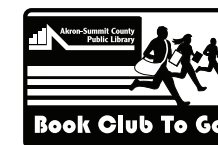
## Find the Alien Hidden in the Library

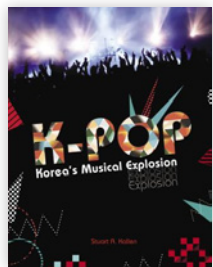
### Pancake Science
