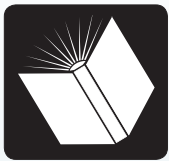

Family History – presented by Judy James, Special Collections and Genealogy Department, Main Library. An informative opportunity to learn how to begin your genealogical search.

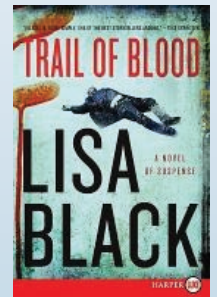


January 24
