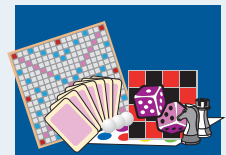
Fleece Scarf December 15

Make sweet treats perfect for gift-giving or enjoying with friends. Sign-up begins January 10.



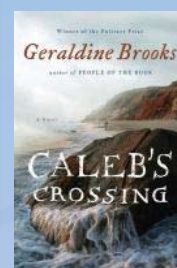
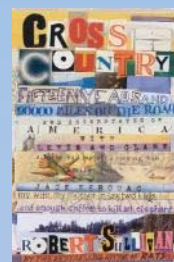
