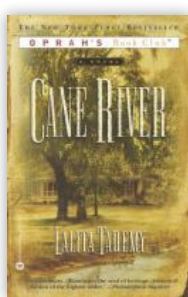
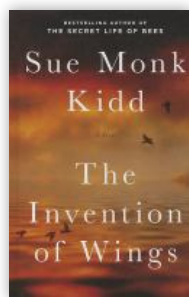
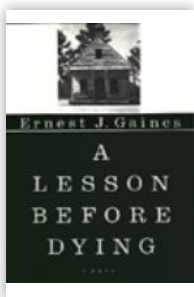
### Book Club on the Run

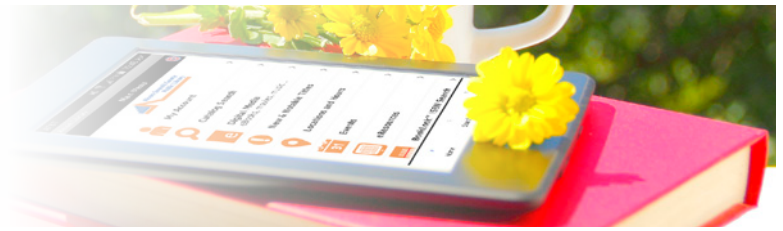
