January 6 – Start the New Year with a paper bag scrapbook

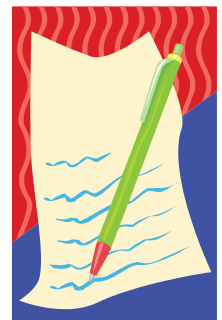

Escape the cold, play some board games and sip some cozy hot chocolate. You can even design your own game and game board.



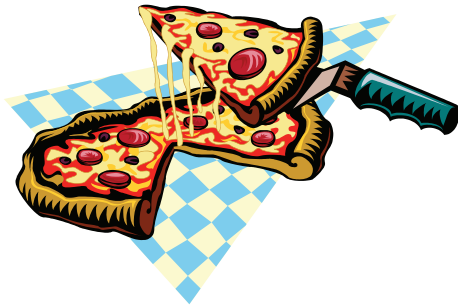
