Kathryn Long will discuss her new mystery, *Buried in Sin*, and the challenges for an author writing and publishing in today's market.

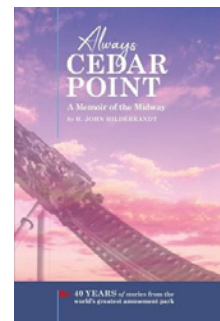

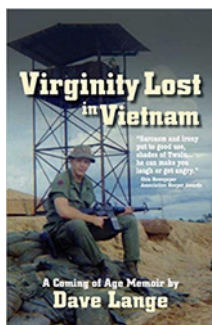
