Diabetes

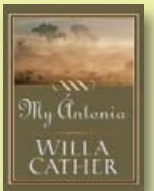
Monday, April 11, 7 pm

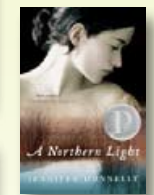

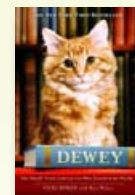

For each gently used article of clothing you bring in, you will get to take that many pieces of



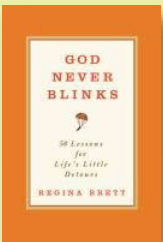
