Give your vocabulary a boost

1. Read so you see the words used in context.
2. Use a dictionary to learn spelling, precise meaning, and alternate definitions.
3. Understand the meaning of words by looking at their etymology, word roots, prefixes and suffixes.
4. Use a thesaurus to find connections between words, such as their synonyms and antonyms.
5. Use a new word in your writing and conversation so you commit it to your memory
6. Learn one new word a day – you will be surprised how quickly they add up.
7. Maintain a list of new words.
8. Make vocabulary improvement a permanent habit in your everyday life.
9. Play and have fun with words. Do crossword puzzles or play games like Scrabble.
10. Learn new words related to different activities in your daily routine: Read, watch a foreign language movie, take up new hobbies, meet new people.

Remember you are only limited by your willingness to learn.
