4. Don't forget: programs for all ages will keep your family busy all summer.



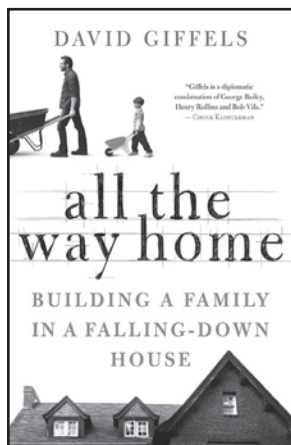
