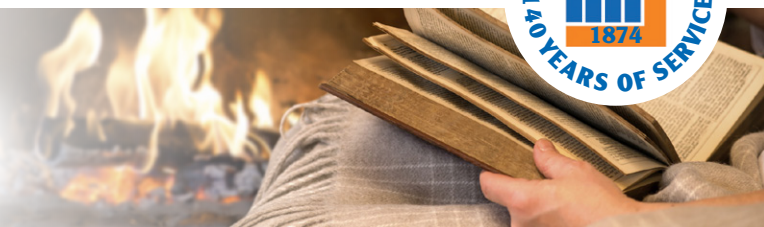

Mosaic Bottles Art 2

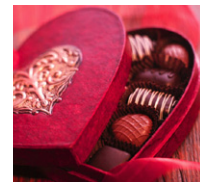
Saturday, January 31, 1 pm

Valentine Chocolates with Bea

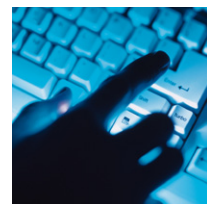
Tuesday, February 10, 5:45 pm
