



### **HALF BROKE HORSES** *by Jeannette Walls*



### **ONE LAST DANCE: IT'S NEVER TOO LATE TO FALL IN LOVE** *by Mardo Williams*


A story about finding love at any age, this is the tale of Morgan, aged 89, and Dixie, 79, two mature individuals on seemingly divergent paths.

### **IDA MAE TUTWEILER & THE TRAVELING TEA PARTY** *by Ginnie Siena-Bivona*



### **THE CORAL THIEF** *by Rebecca Stott*


In 1815 France, a young medical student discovers that the beauty who shared his coach has stolen the rare coral specimens he carried.
