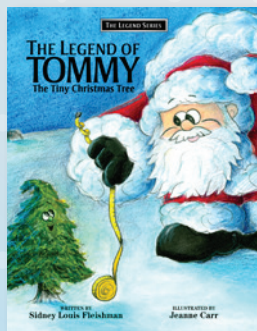
### Local Author Sidney Fleishman and Illustrator Jeanne Carr of Lucky Publishing
