How the program works:

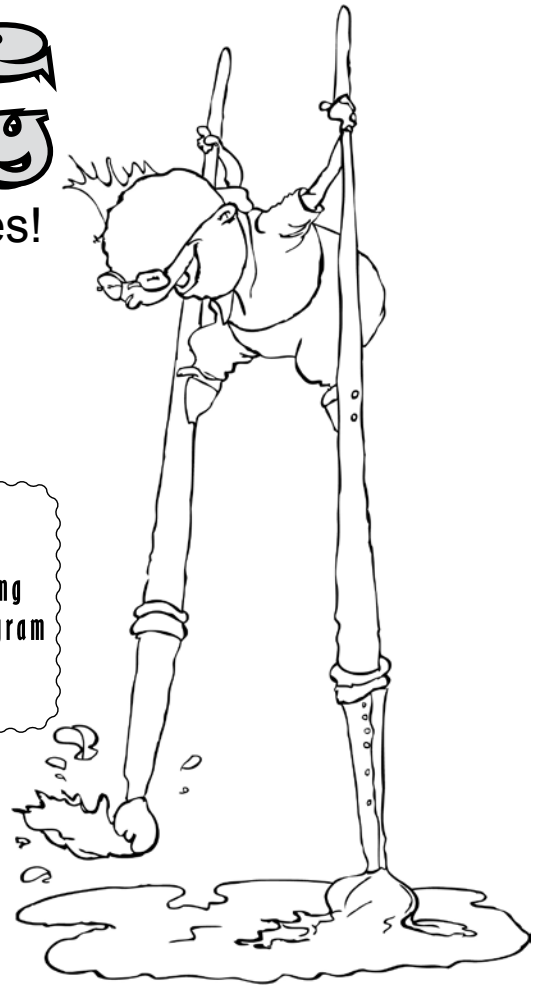
1. Check out a book from your Library and read it!
