### Evening Book Discussions

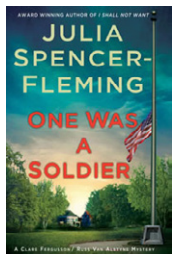
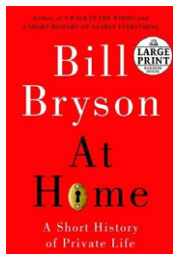
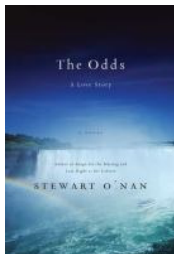
