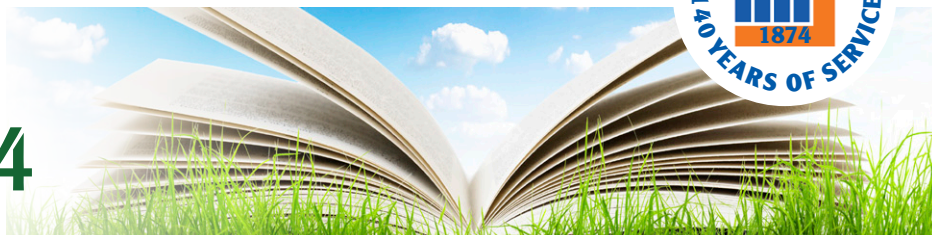

2 pm

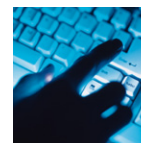
Computer classes are free, hands-on, and about 90 minutes in duration.
