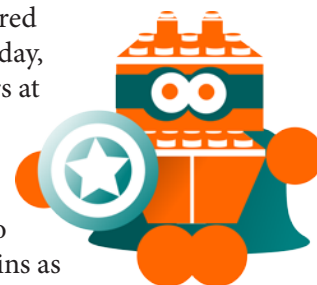

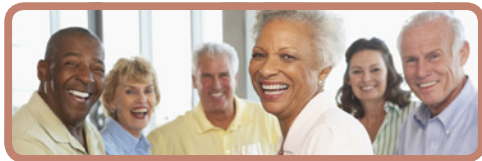
For students in grades 3 and up. Celebrate the Caped Crusader and his enduring legacy through special games and activities. Costumes are welcome but not required.
