One Monday each month at 4 pm, we will read a different chapter book and then come in and talk about it with others over a drink and snack.

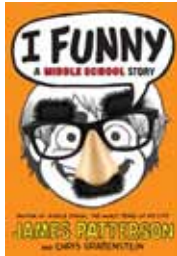

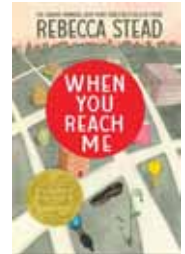
Do you like to see how things work? Are you a hands-on type of kid? This program is for you! Children school age and up bring moms, dads, and the whole family.
