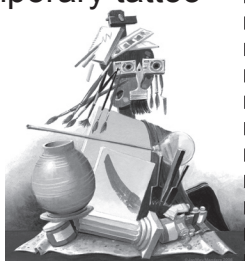

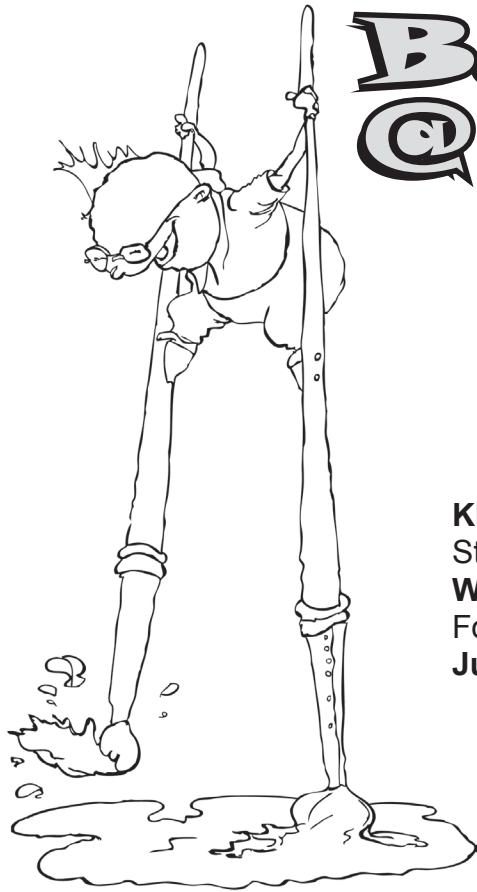

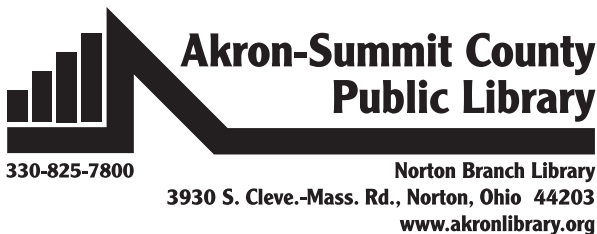
An Akron Storytelling Festival Program for children ages 5 and up
