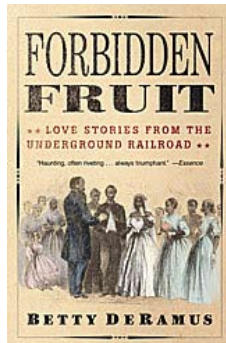
Book Discussion for Adults

Forbidden Fruit: Love Stories from the Underground by

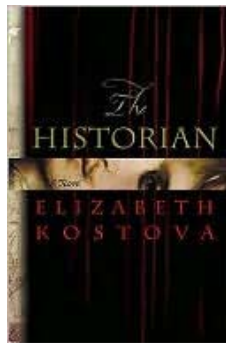

The Historian by Elizabeth Kostova.

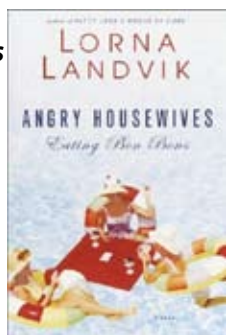
