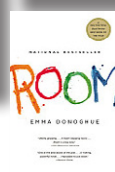
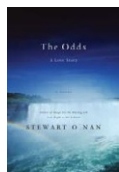
Book Discussion for Adults

No registration is required but you must have a ticket to be admitted. 15 tickets will be distributed 30 minutes prior to the start of class.

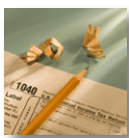
