First Wednesday of the month, 1 pm

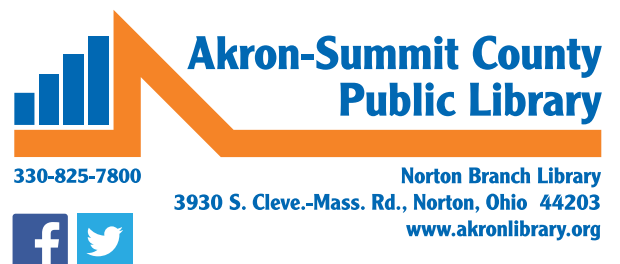
No registration is necessary. Join us for books, conversation and refreshments. Stop at the circulation desk to pick up a copy of the current title.
