Book Club on the Go

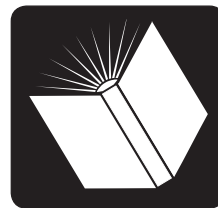
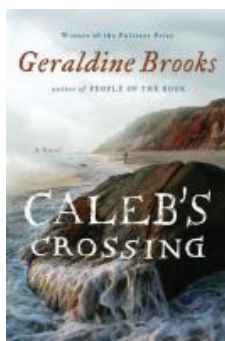
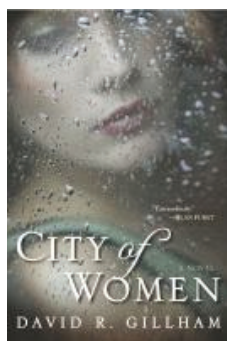
