E-reader Holiday Extravaganza

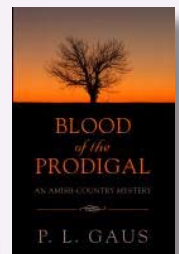

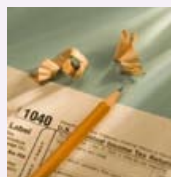
