Dr. Georgette Constantinou, a licensed pediatric psychologist, serves as Administrative Director of the Division of Pediatric Psychiatry and Psychology, and as Co-Director of the NeuroDevelopmental Center at Akron Children's Hospital, will be on hand to answer questions. She is also an Associate Professor of Psychology at the Northeastern Ohio Universities Colleges of Medicine and Pharmacy. Dr. Constantinou is a frequent speaker on parenting issues, child development, family dynamics, bullying and relational aggression among young people as well as other pediatric mental health issues.
