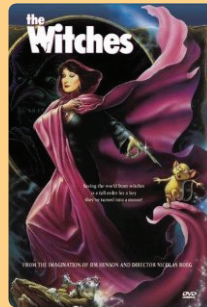
FAMILY PROGRAMS

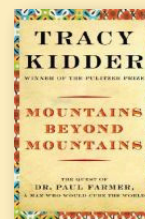
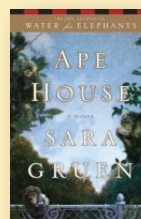
