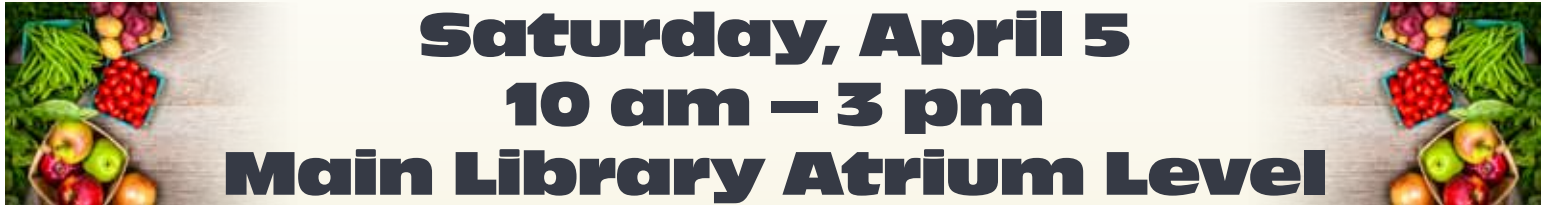

Celebrate LOCAL FOOD
