



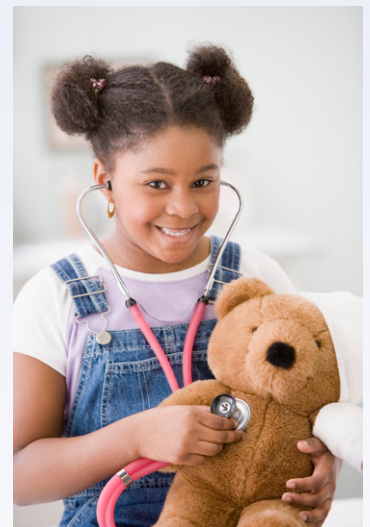
Lead Poisoning: What We Can Do
