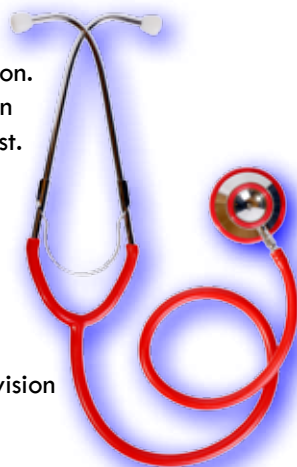
Learn how to find websites, databases, and journal articles that offer scientifically-based information that has already been evaluated by medical experts.
