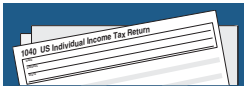

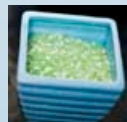

Do you love to knit or crochet? Join us as we make items to be donated to the needy, or work on your own project. Basic instruction and materials provided to new crafters.

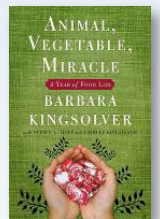
