Funky Foods with Chef Sarah

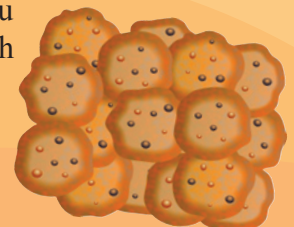
