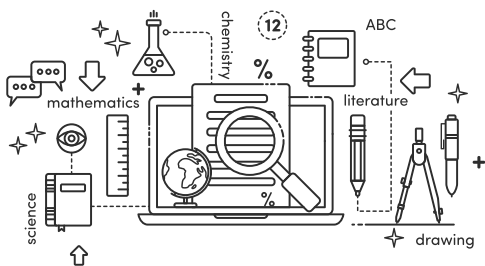
**S.T.E.A.M. for grades 3-5**

##### with NatureConnect

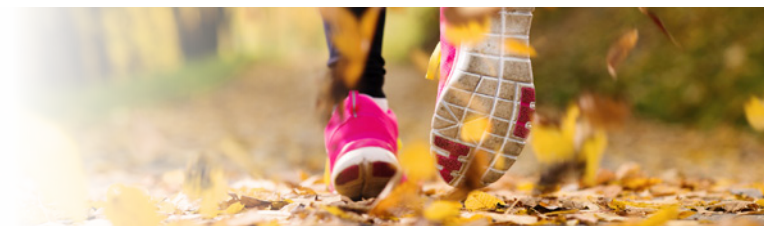
**September:** Get up close and personal with leaves. Create leaf rubbings and add them to our NatureConnect tree.
