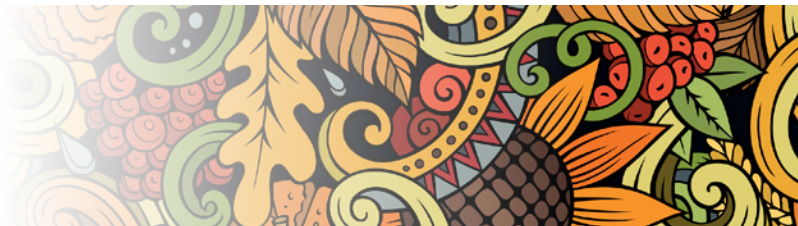

Teens in Tech

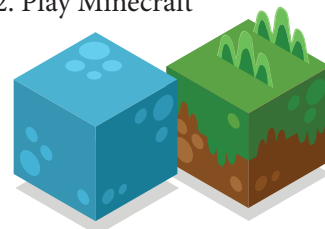
Saturday, September 17, 3 pm

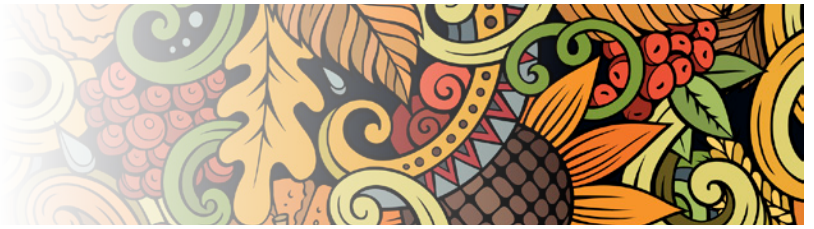
Minecraft
